Responsibilities:

- Develop video concepts with input from Director of Operations, Education Director, and Lead Teachers.
- Edit footage into a short film of 5-10 minutes, which will be in Spanish and may require translation.

Qualifications:

- Fluent in Spanish.
- Experience with filming and video editing.
- Demonstrated ability to complete a short film from pre- through post-production stages.
- Access to video camera and editing software.
- Creativity and love of children.
- Be active and energetic, as will be outdoors most days and children are often in motion.
- Complete all Act 33 and 34 clearances and FBI fingerprinting process as well as Criminal Background Check.

Spanish fluency is required.
